Paperwork to Return to School: We are still in need of some paperwork to be returned to Beals. You may send to school with your child, through the US Mail, or drop off in the box out front of the school anytime between 8:00am-4:30pm the following items:

- SAFI form (student information form) and signed Handbook Acknowledgement form
- Updated health records
- Nutrition Services Free and Reduced Lunch Applications (**ALL students are eligible for FREE breakfast/lunch until December 11, 2020**)

What Do I Need To Bring The First Day of School?

- Fully charged iPad (leave the cord and charging block at home)
- Math workbook pages
- 2 Reading books
- Science book
- Headphones (if you did not pick the ones OPS is providing, they will be given to your child his/her first day back)
- Library books from last school year
- Paperwork listed above
- Medications or health plans for the school nurse
- Water bottle (the drinking fountains will not be in use; classrooms have a sink for refills)

Procedures for the Return to Learn Plan

- A facial covering (mask) must be worn by all staff and students while in the building. Bandanas are not allowed. Students may not enter the building without wearing a facial covering. If parents/guardians are outside of vehicles to pick up or drop off, please wear a facial covering.
- Staff and students will practice social distancing at all times while at school. This includes hallways, lunch, recess, classroom instruction, etc.
- Visitors will not be allowed in the building. Unfortunately parents/guardians will not be able to walk students into their classrooms. We have many staff ready to assist students inside and outside of the building.
- Arrival of students: Students will line up outside of the building and enter the west doors at 8:35am. Please make sure your child is standing on the designated place markers to ensure social distancing. Families may stand together.
- Dismissal of students: Dismissal remains 4:05pm. PreK and Kinder will dismiss into the tear drop parking lot. Please make sure you have your parking pass displayed to enter the lot. Teachers will walk students out to the lower lot, or the overpass on 48th Street. If your child attends Kids Club or rides the bus, a staff member will assist them in getting to their proper location.
